Under the same program, he recently concluded a scoping study for the Myanmar off-grid electrification market.

Prior to The Rockefeller Foundation, Sanjay worked for more than two decades in the corporate sector, mainly in the energy, power products and automotive industries. He has been the Executive Vice President with ACME Energy (Micro Turbine Division), CEO of Imergy Power Systems (US-based flow-battery company),



President and CEO of Birla Power (power products company), and Regional Director (South Asia & Middle East) for Corning Incorporated.
